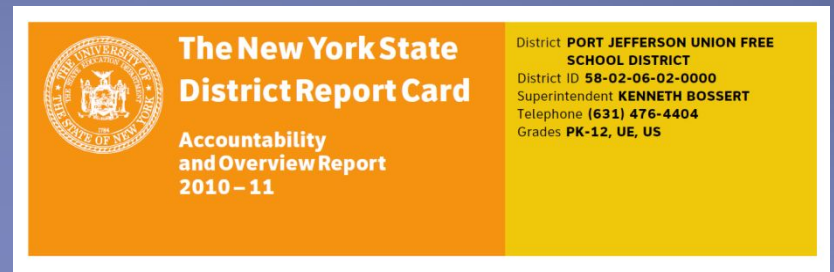

- K-12 enrollment was static with a slight decrease at the elementary level and a slight increase at the secondary level. (*Beds Day, October 2010*)

Regents Exams

- 97% of graduates earned a Regents Diploma.
- 62% of graduates earned a Regents Diploma with Advanced Designation.
- In 8 of 12 Regents exams the percentage of students earning 65 or higher increased or stayed the same.
- In 10 of 12 Regents exams the percentage of students earning 85 or higher increased.

Scores are based on a 0-100 scale

- Mastery: 85-100
- Passing: 65-100
- Safety Net: 55-64

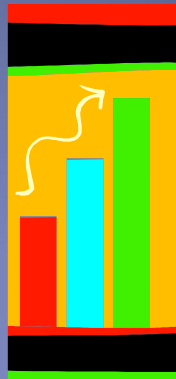
