Dear Parents and Guardians:

With June in the very near future, we wanted to share some changes to the posted school academic calendar. In years past, the last day of traditional classes ended a few days prior to the start of Regents week which allowed students to have a culminating exam in classes that did not offer a Regents exam. This year the Regents exam week has been shortened so we will have traditional classes up to and including part of Regents Exam week.

There may be some in-class final exams or projects prior to the start of Regents Week. Please see below for a tentative calendar of days for the last two weeks of June 2021:

During the additional school days students may be working on culminating class projects, reviewing for their respective Regents exams with their teacher, or turning in any owed school district materials (ex. textbooks, calculators, etc.).

The last day of school for all students is Friday, June 25 (Rating Day). Students should arrive by 7:25 a.m. and will be dismissed at approximately 8:05 a.m. At this time, students should make sure all textbooks, library books and/or uniforms and equipment have been returned to the appropriate office, all lockers are cleaned out, and questions are answered regarding any summer assignment. The official report card will be posted on the Parent Portal on Monday, June 28, 2021.
