2021-2022 AP EXAM INFORMATION/SCHEDULE

Dear Parents, Guardians and Students:

On Monday, May 2, 2022, ELVHS will commence our AP Exam administration, and conclude our exams on Friday, May 13, 2022. Below is our testing schedule outlining which exams will be administered during Week 1 (May 2 - May 6) and Week 2 (May 9 - May 13). In addition, all exams are at the school in pen and paper format except AP World History: Modern, which will be taken on campus in the digital format.

At this time, our teachers have spoken with students to share information regarding the format, date, and time for each AP examination. Based on the feedback received from students and teachers, we have ordered the appropriate exams for our AP students. Please see the schedule below.

Test Room Protocols

What Are Students Allowed To Bring Into a Testing Room?

Two sharpened No. 2 pencils (with erasers) for completing multiple-choice answer sheets.

Two pens with black or dark blue ink only, for completing areas on the exam booklet covers and for free-response questions in most exams.

Up to two calculators with the necessary capabilities if taking an AP Biology, Calculus, Chemistry, Environmental Science, Physics, or Statistics Exam. Instruct students to visit apstudents.org/courses and click on the link for their course for the specific calculator policy.

A ruler or straightedge if taking an AP Physics Exam.

What Are Students NOT Allowed To Bring Into a Testing Room?

Electronic equipment of any kind: phones, smartwatches, or wearable technology of any kind, laptops, tablet computers, Bluetooth devices, portable listening or recording devices—MP3 player, iPod, etc.—cameras or other photographic equipment, devices that can access the internet, separate timers of any type, and any other electronic or communication devices. Any watches that may beep or have an alarm.

Books, compasses, correction fluid, dictionaries, highlighters, notes, mechanical pencils, No.3 pencils, colored pencils, or protractors.

Scratch paper (notes can be made on portions of the exam booklets or, for Chinese Language and Culture and Japanese Language and Culture, on scratch paper provided by the proctor).

Clothing or shoes with subject-related information, food, or drinks.

Please note, students who test digitally will be required to use their school issued Chromebook as all specific AP Test Administration applications will be downloaded to each device by our District Systems Administrator.

All students must report to the school building 30 minutes prior to the start of the exam administration to ensure that all testing protocols are reviewed prior to the start of the exams. All students will test in-person during the school day at 8:00 AM and/or 12:00 PM.

All students who have exam conflicts have been notified of any exams they may be taking during a different date/time and possibly format. In addition, all students who have registered testing accommodations with College Board will receive their accommodations regardless of the format chosen for their exam. Testing accommodations are available in both digital and inperson (pen and paper) formats.

We look forward to working with you and your students during the AP Examination administration.
