Return to School after Illness:

Students who *were sent home from school or did not attend school for a fever or multiple Covid like symptoms* may return to school with:

A note from a health care provider clearing the child to return to school

OR

A negative Covid test.

According to the NYSDOH, Covid symptoms include: Fever (100.0+), cough or sore throat, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, fever, chills, body aches, headache, fatigue, new loss of taste or smell, loss of appetite, nausea/vomiting, nasal congestion/runny nose

Students who have *a confirmed diagnosis of Covid* can return to school if:

It has been at least ten days since the individual first had symptoms

AND

It has been at least three days since the individual has had a fever (without using fever reducing medicine)

AND

It has been at least three days since the individual's symptoms improved.

AND

They are released from the local Department of Health
