Dear Parent/Guardian:

Enclosed is important information regarding end-of-year procedures, timelines, and schedules for the high school. Please review the material in this mailing and go over it with your child to ensure their attendance at all required finals and Regents exams.

The last day of regular classes at the high school is Thursday, June 9. Final examinations will be given on Friday, June 10, Monday, June 13 and Tuesday, June 14. Individual subject area teachers will inform students of the date and time, and the room assignments for each final exam. Regents exam and transportation information can be found on the enclosed schedule.

All New York State Regents examinations will be administered on June 15 through June 23, in both morning and afternoon testing sessions. Tests will begin promptly and students should plan on arriving by 7:45 a.m. for the morning sessions and 11:45 a.m. for the afternoon sessions. Only students who are taking a Regents examination are required to be in school during these days. If your child is scheduled for a Regents examination, please be certain that they are aware of the date, time, and room of the examination. Regents examinations must be taken at the scheduled time (not all Regents exams are offered during the New York State summer testing schedule).

The last day of school for students is Friday, June 24. Please be advised that only those students who need to complete the following tasks should attend school:

- Students who are returning school textbooks, library books and/or uniforms and equipment
- Students requiring information about summer school

All other students are not required to attend. Students will arrive by 7:25 a.m. on their regularly scheduled bus and will be dismissed at approximately 8:05 a.m. Please note that report cards will not be distributed at this time, official grades will be posted to the Parent Portal on Monday, June 27, 2022.

Seniors are reminded that the PTSA will be hosting a "Senior Breakfast" in the cafeteria on Friday, June 24. Immediately following the breakfast there will be a mandatory graduation rehearsal. All seniors must attend this rehearsal. Graduation will take place on Friday evening, June 24, 2022. Seniors must report to the gymnasium by 5:30 p.m. to prepare for the graduation procession.

Our students have worked diligently throughout the year and we are confident their continued efforts will result in many successes as they conclude the school year. Congratulations to our seniors; we look forward to hearing of their accomplishments in the coming year. Dear Parent/Guardian:

The high school will be hosting an Advanced Placement (AP) Summer Assignment Seminar on Tuesday, June 21, 2022 at 12 noon at Earl L. Vandermeulen High School. Buses have been arranged with the pick-up run beginning at 11:15 a.m. (with an arrival by 11:45 a.m.). The buses will depart the school approximately at 1:30 p.m. Students enrolled in AP courses for the 2022-2023 are expected to attend the seminar to learn about the summer assignments for their AP classes and receive materials and books, as needed.

Each AP teacher will present the summer assignment for their class and will repeat the presentation every 20 minutes, at 12:00 p.m., 12:20 p.m., 12:40 p.m., and 1:00 p.m. Students will have the opportunity to visit up to four AP teachers during the seminar.

If your child is unable to attend, arrangements should be made directly with the teacher at a mutually convenient time before the last day of school. If a convenient time cannot be found, the materials and assignments may be picked up in July by calling the main office.
