The following all counts as community service:

*Any unpaid work done for a 501c3 organization (tax-exempt)

Habitat for Humanity, Museums, Toys for Tots, Red Cross, Scouts, Rotary, Lions Club

*Volunteer work at libraries, firehouses, schools, religious centers.

Special events, alter serving, church choir, clean-up, Bible camp.

*Free theater productions for the community, concerts (No rehearsal, meeting or practice time).

Dickens Festival, band, orchestra, plays

*Helping coach or teach younger children at sports camps

Beach camp, junior coaches

*Events such as a baseball game, dodgeball, walks etc. to benefit Cancer/Diabetes research

*School events

Sponsored by: PTA, PTSA, Student government, Leo Club, Interact Club etc

*Volunteering at nursing homes, hospitals, shelters, food pantries, soup kitchens etc

Coat or food drives

*Beach/town/village clean up

No time spent at meetings, practices or rehearsals.

Nothing in which the student receives any type of payment for helping.
